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Orthopaedic Residency

Initial accreditation earned in 2012

Woman's Health Residency

Initial accreditation earned in 2016

4 components to our residency programs:

Clinical -each participant will see a full (40hr/week) case load of patients that covers all diagnostic categories/areas of the specific program they are participating in

Mentoring -each resident will receive 4.5 hours of one-on-one clinical mentoring per week totaling over 200 hours for the year

Didactics-including 3 hours per week of classroom lectures and hands-on lab sessions, as well as at home reading assignments

Research-journal clubs, case report presentations, and participation in research projects

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Loyola Medical Center Residency Programs



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Tuition cost: \$3,500

Application Fee: \$50

Books and additional fees: \$600

Applicants must have APTA membership and include appropriate specialty section memberships, CPR certification, and a valid PT license to practice in IL

Residents earn an hourly rate equal to a level 1 physical therapist at Loyola Medicine. Residents are only paid during patient care hours. Residents are not paid for didactic sessions, research activities, or time reading and studying individually

Benefits (PTO, Medical, Dental) are **not** included. Residents must obtain benefits individually

Residents are required to work 40 hours per week of patient care

Additional time is required to attend weekly didactic lab sessions, individual reading and studying, and research activities outside of the required 40 hours patient care work day.

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Physical Therapy Orthopaedic Clinical Residency Program



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- Total number of program graduates: 30
- Program completion rate: 100%
- Total number of graduates that have successfully passed the ABPTS Orthopaedic Clinical Specialist Examination (OCS):
29 graduates have taken the exam and 27 have passed resulting in 93% passing rate
- Average clinic productivity for resident graduates: 80%
- Average improvement in patient reported pain scores pre vs. post program completion: 5%
- Average improvement in patient reported functional outcome scores pre vs. post program completion: 2%
- Average reduction in number of clinic visits per patient (patient length of stay) pre vs. post program: 2% reduction in clinic visits per patient

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Physical Therapy Women's Health Clinical Residency Program



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- Total number of program graduates: 12
- Program completion rate: 100%
- Total number of graduates successfully passing the ABPTS Woman's Health Clinical Specialist Examination (WCS):
11 graduates have taken the exam and all 11 have passed resulting in 100% passing rate
- Average reduction in number of clinic visits per patient (patient length of stay) pre vs. post program: 8% reduction in clinic visits per patient
- Average reduction in no show rate for patients seen by graduate pre vs. post program completion: 2%

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
